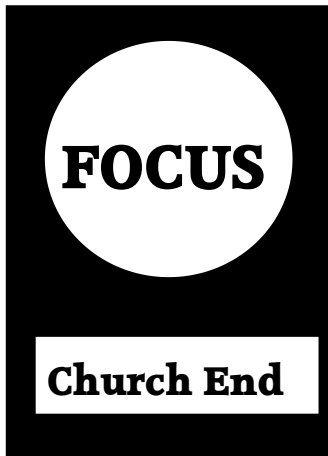

PLANNING PERMISSIONS FOR 29 ST RONANS REFUSED

We are grateful to the Focus Team for giving us the opportunity to say thank you to the Councillors and residents of Laings Estate following the refusal by the Regional Planning Committee West at its meeting on March 8th.

We would particularly like to convey our thanks to Cllr Richard Hoskins who argued the case that the proposed plans did not satisfy the Council's own planning regulations and policies and backed by Councillor Felicity Banks won the support of the whole Regional Committee West Councillors to have the application refused.

We equally recognise the support of the residents of the Laings Estate Residential Precinct and would like to extend our thanks for your contribution in showing your objection to this development. The letters to the Council and signatures to the petition contributed towards this decision and fortunately on this occasion we achieved our goal to preserve the character of our lovely neighbourhood and prevented an intrusive and unsightly addition.

We must therefore be mindful to remain vigilant in the future if we are to continue to succeed against inappropriate development, not only to protect but moreover to enhance our Residential Precinct for the benefit of everyone.
